**Here is a checklist of agencies/organizations/documents you will need to update
(This is not an all-inclusive list):**

Personal

- Employer
- Former employers (If you have pensions or benefits)
- Medical providers (Doctor, dentist, eye doctor, veterinarian)
- Schools and daycare
- Courts (For matters involving custody, divorce, etc.)
- Insurance (Auto, home, health, life, etc.)
- Membership (Gym, newspapers, club, etc.)

PennDOT

- Driver's license (No charge due to 911 implementation)
- Vehicle registration (No charge due to 911 implementation)

Financial Institutions

- Bank
- Credit Union
- Credit Card companies (Bank, department store, etc.)
- Financial Advisor, credit card and other financial institutions.
- Social Security Administration (Only if you receive benefits)

Utilities

- Electric (PPL)
- Gas Company (UGI)
- Fuel Oil Company/Propane Company/Coal Company
- Water/sewer department
- Telephone
- Cellular phone
- Cable Company or Satellite TV
- Internet Service

Professional Licensing

- Check with your professional licensing boards to see when you need to update your new address

Passports - Update the address when you renew; Passports cannot be used for travel within six months of expiration

NOTE: The post office will deliver to both your old address and new address for up to one year.

NOTE: You can continue to use your current checks provided your account numbers stay the same; just update your checks when you need to reorder.
